


BOOK CLUB GUIDE

About the Book:

Discussion Questions:

- 5. What do you think happens after the book ends?
- 6. What do you think the author is trying to say to the reader?
- 7. Did Evelyn see her dead husband's ghost or something else?
- 8. Describe how the main character changed over the course of the book.
- 9. Do you believe Evelyn should have gone after Nathaniel? Why?
- 10. Did your opinions about any of the characters change?
