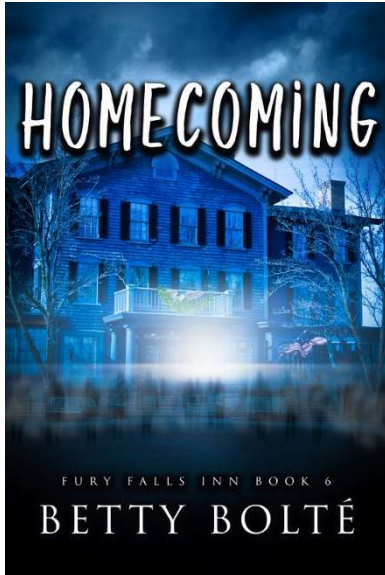




# BOOK CLUB GUIDE

### About the Book:

10. What does the title mean? How does it relate to the story?
