


BOOK CLUB GUIDE

About the Book:

Discussion Questions:

- 2. Did this story seem realistic?

- 4. Did you pick up on any symbolism in the story? What do these objects actually mean? How do the characters interact with these objects?
- 5. Does the structure add to or detract from the ideas and themes the author tries to present?
- 6. How did Trent's opinion of Samantha's practice change through the course of the story?
- 7. What flaws does the protagonist have?
- 8. What role did Thistle play in the story? What might Samantha learn from the dog?
- 9. Are the characters likable? What does that mean for the story? Which character do you most relate to?
- 10. How did Samantha come to terms with the challenges she faced and ultimately overcame?
