About the Book:

Discussion Questions:

2. Tara has a strong reluctance to cook or bake. Why and how does she move past that dread?
3. What's your favorite quote or passage?
4. Raven Hollow as a place is a nod by the author to Edgar Allan Poe. What other elements of the story point to this tribute?
5. How does the setting affect the theme, characters, and plot? Could it have happened anywhere, at any time? If so, how would the novel have changed?
6. What strengths does the antagonist have (if there is one)?
7. What does Grant learn about himself while trapped in Raven Hollow?
8. What do you think the author is trying to say to the reader?
9. Tara helps her family come together over their first Thanksgiving dinner together. What does she learn as a result?
10. Did you pick up on any symbolism in the story? What do these objects actually mean? How do the characters interact with these objects?
